- The primary use of the studio is for academic use. Rentals are made on an as-available basis
- Although Bryant University endeavors to keep its equipment and facilities in immaculate condition we can not guarantee this will be the case at all times. In the event that rented equipment is damaged, broken or otherwise unable to perform as required and/or specified all good faith attempts will be made to replace or repair said equipment. Should any studio time be lost due to equipment of facility issues the time will be credited to the client accordingly.
- All clients must be properly insured as Bryant University assumes no responsibility related to bodily injury, lost, stole or otherwise damaged property.
- Any damages incurred to campus facilities or equipment will be charged accordingly to the client responsible. Furthermore, Bryant University reserves the right to terminate any client's studio related activities if campus officials deem it in the best interest of the campus and/or its members.

Restrictions -

- Bryant University restricts the use of studio facilities to "decent" usages only; examples of indecent filming would include, but is not limited to, pornography or scenes of graphic violence.
- The usage of livestock or other animals in general is not allowed; however, special permission can be sought and will be dealt with on a case by case basis.
- Under no circumstances will the usage of pyrotechnics, open flames, or any other incendiary devices be allowed.

Studio Rental Rates

- \$300 ½ day (approximately 4 hours) for Studio Floor rental*
Floor Specified as: actual studio floor, lighting and grip, including ETC Light Board, Spots, Floods, Soft Lights, assorted grip w/cart, barn doors, scrims and screens.
- \$200 ½ day (approximately 4 hours) for Control Room rental**
Studio Specified as: (3) Sony DVCPro Cameras, Sound booth, teleprompter system, two large floor monitors, Intercom & IFB setup, microphone jacks, Video Wall, Chyron Character Generator, Thomson/Grass Valley Kayak Production Switcher, Tuscum Digital Sound Board, and (3) Panasonic DVCPro VTRs
- \$50 discounts apply to both rental items per 1/2 day of rental for employing Bryant student Production Assistants.

***Studio Rental requires allowing members of the Bryant Community to observe the production procedures.**
