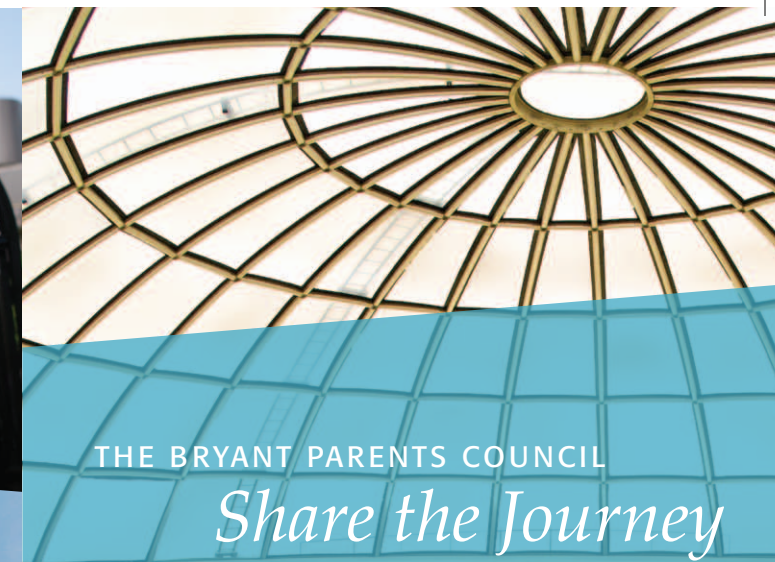

- Access to more than 150,000 items, including 20,000-plus print and electronic journal subscriptions and databases, with more being added every year to meet evolving curriculum needs and advances in information technology.
- Training in the latest research methodologies so that students are able to use library resources effectively as they navigate Bryant's challenging curriculum.
- Access to career information including databases that provide company information students use to learn about potential employers.
