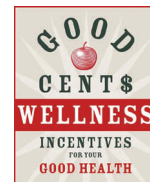


Good Cent\$ Wellness Program Incentives for Your Good Health Annual Well Visit Affidavit



As part of Bryant University's Good Cent\$ Wellness Program, faculty, staff and spouses/domestic partners are encouraged to have an annual well visit. Annual well visits are important because preventive measures may be recommended and may lead to an overall healthy lifestyle. Eligible faculty, staff and spouses/domestic partners may earn an incentive credit for simply having an annual well visit in 2010.

To receive the \$25 incentive credit, eligible faculty and staff must:

Attend an on-site Biometric Screening Clinic (November 10th or 12th, 2010)

OR

Complete this Annual Well Visit Affidavit, with physician's signature

To receive the \$15 incentive credit, eligible spouses/domestic partners must:
