


How to Search for Modes of Thought or Humanities Survey course options

Click and drag to highlight all of the “Subjects”

Under “Attribute” choose the requirement you are looking to fulfill. (Ex: Historical Mode of Thought, Literary Mode of Thought, Cultural Mode of Thought, Social Science Mode of Thought, Humanities Survey English, Humanities Survey History).

All of the courses that fulfill the specified attribute will show up.
