HOW TO APPLY

You can start your application at www.commonapp.org

WHAT TO INCLUDE

All **international first-year students** must submit:

- Their application with a \$50 fee
- Transcripts detailing your academic achievement for the last three years of secondary school. This varies from country to country (please contact the Admission Office with questions).
- At least one recommendation (but no more than three) from a counselor and/or teacher(s)
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) scores. Bryant also accepts the Duolingo English Test; results from the DET will be evaluated case by case.
- ACT/SAT scores or opt to apply Test Optional. Exams scores may be eligible for a waiver; contact the Admission Office with questions.
- The Certificate of Finances and supporting bank statements (upon acceptance to Bryant)

All **international transfer students** must submit the following:

- Their application and a \$50 fee
- A final, official secondary school transcript or statement of marks
- All college/university transcripts and a list of courses (if not included on transcripts) that you expect to complete before the proposed date of transfer
- Course descriptions or syllabi with English translations needed for transfer credit evaluation
- Evidence of English language proficiency (e.g. TOEFL, IELTS).
- The Certificate of Finances and supporting bank documents (upon acceptance to Bryant)

Please note: Photocopied documents will not be accepted.

TUITION AND FEES

Tuition and fees for the 2022-2023 academic year:

- Tuition and fees: \$48,432 (includes a personal laptop computer)
- Residence (includes 14 meals per week): \$16,534
- Student fees: \$829

SCHOLARSHIPS

International students are considered for merit-based scholarships ranging from \$8,000 to \$35,000 USD per year. Scholarships are based on the application for admission and are renewable.
